

Dear new HJ2302 owner,

We wish to bring to your attention an issue that may save you some frustration. This machine features a locking pin, which allows the user to lock the dolly into place so that the hydraulics are under no load. The photo below shows this pin with a finger pointing to it.



Should you choose to lower this pin into the locked position, it is imperative you do not forget you have done this and proceed to operate the machine by pumping on the hand pump. Doing so will surely cause damage to the machine by elongating the safety locking holes as shown below



As well as likely breaking the hydraulic plunger, pictured below with a finger pointing at it.



Resulting in damage that looks like this:



Should this error be made and this damage occur, it is not considered "under warranty" and replacement parts will be sold to the customer to rectify the issue. Thus, please be careful and aware the safety locking pin is always in the upward, disengaged position before operating the hand pump on this dolly. We thank you for your attention and your business.
